


The 4-H Military Partnership between DoD and USDA was established in 1995 to serve and support military youth, teens, families and military Child and Youth Programs professionals.

- ➤ Ask questions! Connect with 4-H & Military POCs
- ➤ Communicate often
- Share calendars & upcoming events to identify potential collaborations
- ➤ Provide 4-H resources, curriculum & swag
- ➤ Network with variety of people on installations
- ➤ Connect at meetings and build community partnerships
- ➤ Share Professional Development opportunities
- ➤ Be open to new ideas and ways of doing business
